The commission discussed this and agreed to let them set it by the porta-potty near the softball field. **Jim** will ask the Booster's Club who will be able to use the cook shack. Jim mentioned that they pay 1/2 the electric that may be put in. Jenny motioned the above, and Ernie seconded. Motion was granted. Jim said that Bob Creano would look at the box.
- Water to Carpenter Field – Ernie said he took care of the water. **Ernie** will discuss the new water line to Alumni field, and water from shut off to field wih.

- Lisa bought up field usage with B-Ball in not using the girls' field. **Demetra** will contact Holly & Laurie as to when they will be using the field and not using the field so others can.
- There was mention of where the field usage money is going when collected. When Theresa gives us budget info we will see.
- Demetra would like to see committees for things to move smoothly. Committee for fundraising, field maintenance etc. Board members would be in-charge of the committee and get assistance from parents and community members.
