Chairman Trottier opened the meeting at 7:01 p.m.

Valley Net: Utility Pole Permit

Mr. John VanVught, representing Valley Net, was present to discuss any questions that might arise from the utility permit application that they are applying for. He noted the application is to install one new utility pole within the town right of way along Waterman Rd. The pole will be placed at the entrance to 415 Waterman Road.

P. Ainsworth made a motion that was seconded by P. Gates to approve utility permit application #10-01. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Concerns

Administrative Assistant Cleveland reported that the holiday lights are once again being placed on the park in the South Royalton Village by Paul Whitney, his wife and members of the fire and rescue squad. Some replacement lights and electrical cords are needed and Mr. Whitney has asked the town to help with the purchase of these supplies.

P. Gates made a motion that was seconded by P. Ainsworth to authorize reimbursing Mr. P. Whitney up to \$250.00 for holiday decoration supplies. The motion passed unanimously.

Administrative Assistant reported that the Recreation Commission has asked for permission to use the South Royalton Village Green on December 18, 2010 for a holiday celebration with Santa.

P. Ainsworth made a motion that was seconded by P. Gates to authorize use of the village green on 12/18/2010 by the Royalton Recreation Commission. The motion passed unanimously.

Proposed FY 2011/2012 Budgets

The Selectboard worked with Town Treasurer Theresa Harrington on the Pollution Abatement Facility, and General Fund budgets. Final budget requests are still needed from various department heads. The Selectboard will hold a budget meeting on December 7, 2010.

Additional Business

Administrative Assistant Cleveland presented information concerning the process to purchase land. He also presented a cost analysis on health insurance plans. The

Selectboard took no action on these items and will discuss them again at the regular scheduled Selectboard meeting on December 14, 2010.
